

Checking On Our Progress with One Click

Just as parents examine their children's report card to see how well they are doing, so, too, can anyone with Internet access look at each Kentucky public school or district's report card to see how they are performing.

School and District Report Cards are posted on the Kentucky Department of Education's (KDE's) website. These Report Cards provide information including test performance, teacher qualifications, student safety, awards, parent involvement and much more.

To access the site, go to <https://applications.education.ky.gov/src/>. By scrolling down a list of districts or schools to highlight the one in question and then clicking on "View Card," a person will see several information-specific tabs, each containing information on one aspect of the school or district.

The first tab, **Profile**, gives an overall picture of the district or school.

Two adjacent tabs are **Accountability and Assessment**. The Accountability Profile summarizes the status of a school or district in the state accountability system, Unbridled Learning: College- and Career-Ready for All.

The Overall Score is used to compare and rank school and district performance and to calculate an AMO (annual measurable objective) improvement goal. An accountability classification based on the percentile rank, rewards or assistance category, participation rate and graduation rate is also displayed.

The **Assessment tab** shows data from several different types of assessments that Kentucky school children take.

Next to it is the **Program Review** which analyzes components of an instructional program including instructional practices, curriculum alignment, assessments, professional development and administrative support.

The current ratings are for Arts and Humanities, Practical Living/Career Skills, Writing, and Primary (K-3). The four rating categories might appear to be about all content areas, but they are representative of these four areas.

The **Learning Environment tab** contains information on student spending, teachers, technology, parent involvement and volunteer hours, school safety, student behavior and discipline, and programs such as special education, migrant, gifted/talented, and English as a second language.

The **Financial tab** reveals fund balances, bonding capacity, SEEK funding in relation to student average daily attendance, and the number of certified and classified staff.

The **Delivery Target tab** indicates incremental progress toward five-year goals, measured annually in such areas as graduation rate, program reviews, college and career readiness, and kindergarten readiness.

The final tab contains career and technical education data which will be loaded on the card later this month.
